THIS WEEK

Bradley travels to Omaha, Neb., for the Omaha Marriott Classic, where the Braves will face Southern Utah Friday afternoon in addition to playing Saturday matchups with in-state foe SIU Edwardsville and tournament-host Omaha. The weekend trip to Omaha kicks off a stretch in which Bradley will play eight of the next nine matches on the road.

SERIES HISTORY

Bradley opens tournament play in Omaha against Southern Utah Friday at 4 p.m. Friday's matchup will be the first meeting between the Braves and Southern Utah. BU will face in-state foe SIU Edwardsville Saturday at 1 p.m., marking the fourth time in the last six years the teams will meet. Bradley has won two of the three previous matchups with the Cougars. The Braves also hold a 2-1 lead in the all-time series with tournament-host Omaha, taking a pair of matches from the Mavericks in Peoria, Ill., to open the 2011 season. Those two prior matchups with UNO were the first two contests at Bradley for third-year BU head coach Jenny Maurer.

STARTING STRONG

Bradley went 2-1 at the season-opening CEFCU Classic, finishing second in the tournament. The Braves are 2-1 or better to start a season for the fifth consecutive year. In 2012, Bradley opened the season with five consecutive victories and the Braves have posted a 4-2 record through the first six matches of the year in three of the prior four years with the 2010 season being the only exception during that stretch (3-3).

HOME TOURNAMENT HISTORY

Bradley hosted an in-season tournament for the 23rd time in the last 30 years. The Braves own a 48-27 (.640) record when hosting a home tournament and snapped a three-match losing streak in home tournament contests with Friday's season-opening victory against Western Illinois. The 2013 CEFCU Classic was Bradley's 11th in-season tournament over the last nine years.

ROAD OPENERS

Bradley won its first true road game of the season in 2012, snapping a 17-match losing streak in the first true road outing of the year, but the Braves will be looking for their third consecutive victory in the first match away from home in a season after last season's neutral site sweep of Elon to open the 2012 campaign. The Braves face Southern Utah Friday afternoon in the first match away from home and have claimed the first neutral site match of the year each of the last four seasons.

ALL-TOURNAMENT HONORS

Senior Amy Angelos was named to the 2013 CEFCU Classic All-Tournament team after pacing the Braves in all three matches to open the season. She tallied a league-best 3.91 kills per set during the opening weekend, while hitting .434 and climbed up five spots on Bradley's career kills chart.

HITTING THE ROAD

Bradley opened the 2013 season at home hosting the CEFCU Classic, marking the fourth time in the last five years the Braves started the season with a home tournament. The schedule for the month of September will be a little tougher for Bradley, which plays eight of the next nine matches on the road. The Braves will play just one home match in the month of September (9/22 vs. Drake) marking Bradley's fewest home matches (4) before Oct. 1 since the 2004 campaign when BU played its home opener on Oct. 1.

BALANCED ATTACK

For the first time since the 2009 season Bradley returned three individuals who notched 200 or more kills the previous season. Senior Alise Tupuritis led the Braves with 309 kills in 2012 as a junior, tallying the highest season kill total for a BU individual since Amber DeBroux in 2006 (361). Fellow senior middle blocker Amy Angelos added a career-best 299 kills last year as a junior, giving Bradley two players with 275 or more kills in the same season for the first time since that 2006 campaign. Junior Courtney Keefe was one of four individuals on the 2012 squad with 200 or more kills, marking the first time the Braves had four players reach 200 kills in the same season since 2004. Bradley is the only team in the Missouri Val-

ley Conference to return two players which ranked in the top 15 in the MVC in kills per set last fall.

CAN YOU DIG IT

Senior libero/defensive specialist Lauren Zerante made the move from outside hitter to libero last year and responded by collecting 498 digs. This season, Zerante opened the year averaging a league-best 6.00 digs per set at the CEFCU Classic, collecting 20 or more digs in all three matches and was named the Missouri Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Week for the week of Sept. 3. Against Maryland Eastern Shore she tied a school record for digs in a three-set match with 22 digs against the Hawks. The 10th player in school history to reach 800 career digs before the start of their senior season, Zerante moved up four spots on Bradley's career digs list into 20th.

2.72 per set in 2013) helping highlight last year's offensive attack. Angelos is the team's active career leader in kills with 852 to rank 16th in school history after starting the year in 21st, while Tupuritis started the year 27th in program history at 698 career kills and has climbed to 24th (726 kills). Bradley boasts a pair of players with 700 or more kills at the same time for the first time since Briony Hammet and Lindsay Stalzer in 2005.

LEADING THE D

Junior Allie Falter finished the 2012 season with a career-best 108 blocks and was the first Bradley player to reach 100 blocks in a season since Lindsay Stalzer had 111 blocks in 2004. Falter averaged 1.05 blocks per set in Missouri Valley Conference play last year as a sophomore. Not to be outdone at the net, senior Amy Angelos has 234 career blocks and needs 73 blocks to break into Bradley's career top 10 after tallying 79 last year.

RETURNING NUMBERS

Bradley is one of just two schools in the Missouri Valley Conference to return at least 80 percent of its kills, assists, digs and blocks from the 2012 season, joining Missouri State in the elite group. The Braves lost outside hitter Madelyn Ervin to graduation, but returned individuals which accounted for 1,134 kills last fall or nearly 84 percent of the team's offense. Only Illinois State and Missouri State return a higher percentage of their offense. In addition to returning both setters used in 2012, BU also brings back nearly 94 percent of the squad's digs from last year, which ranks as the

highest percentage in the MVC in 2013 and almost 81 percent of the team's blocks.

BU PICKED EIGHTH IN MVC POLL

Bradley was picked to finish eighth in the MVC according to a pre-season vote of league coaches. The Braves received 35 points for the second consecutive year, finishing two points behind seventh-place Evansville (37) and nine back of conference newcomer Loyola (6th - 44). Wichita State, which is ranked 24th in the AVCA preseason coaches' poll garnered eight of 10 first-place votes and is the preseason league favorite.

UP NEXT

Bradley closes out the non-conference portion of the schedule at the Billiken Challenge in St. Louis, Mo., Sept. 13 & 14, where the Braves will take on Youngstown State, Miami (Ohio) and tournament-host Saint Louis. The matchup with Youngstown State will be the first meeting between the two squads, while BU will play Miami (Ohio) for the first time since 1990. The Redhawks own a 2-0 lead in the all-time series with the Braves. Next Saturday's matchup with Saint Louis will be the 23rd all-time meeting. Bradley and the Billikens have split the previous 22 contests in the series 11-11 and Saint Louis has won the last three meetings overall. The Braves are 3-2 in matches in St. Louis against the Billikens since 1984.
