THE STATE'S NEWEST DIVISION I TEAM

After finding great success in NCAA Division II, Omaha began a four-year reclassification period to NCAA Division I in 2011-12. That makes UNO the newest Division I men's basketball program in the state! Moving to Division I means that UNO can combine its long-standing tradition of excellence with opportunities to play high-profile opponents all season long.

In 2013-14, the Mavericks made their first Division I postseason appearance in school history, receiving an at-large bid to the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) and advancing to the second round of play after defeating North Dakota. This past season, Omaha ranked among the best teams in the country for points per game and steals per game, finishing in the top 25 nationally in those categories.

HEAD COACH DERRIN HANSEN



Head Coach Derrin Hansen enters his 11th season at the helm of the Omaha men's basketball program in 2015-16, carrying a career record of 161-138 (.538) in 10 years. He guided the Mavericks to two NCAA Division II Tournament appearances and conference championships in the North Central Conference (2008) and Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association (2010) before UNO announced its reclassification to Division I beginning with the 2011-12 season.

Hansen ranks second all-time in school history with 161 career victories. He has coached four players to Daktronics All-Region accolades and had one student-athlete earn All-America honorable mention. In addition, five of Hansen's players won eight All-MIAA awards, four earned All-NCC recognition and five have secured All-Summit accolades in UNO's first three years in the Summit League.

Before taking his post as head coach, Hansen also served as an assistant coach at UNO for seven seasons from 1998 to 2005. He helped the program to a 131-73 record, two NCC regular-season championships, one tournament crown and three trips to the NCAA Division II Tournament.

Hansen is a native of St. Paul, Neb. He earned his bachelor's degree from Nebraska Wesleyan in 1991 after playing four years for the Plainsmen and earned his master's degree from Nebraska-Kearney in 1995. Hansen is an active member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches and the Nebraska Coaches Association.

CAMP DESCRIPTIONS

OFFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT CAMPS

Any player looking to develop his offensive game needs to attend the **Offensive Improvement Camps**. All stations, contests and activities are geared toward developing the all-around offensive player. Shooting, passing, screening and dribbling are just a few of the main skill sets that will be emphasized throughout the week. In addition to a strong emphasis on the fundamentals, the camp will have daily contests that allow campers to compete against themselves to improve each day, as well as against other campers their age.

After putting in hard work during stations and fundamental breakdown segments, campers will be rewarded with the opportunity to play games and showcase the new skills they have learned or improved throughout camp.

INDIVIDUAL SKILLS CAMPS

In order to become a great basketball player, you must be fundamentally sound in all areas of the game. **Individual Skills Camps** are the camps to help you do just that! In these camps, players will be divided up according to grade level and will be given numerous opportunities to improve their skills. Campers will take part in contests and play league games, with a chance to compete for championships. We will work on developing all skills -- ball handling, passing, shooting and rebounding, as well as individual and team defense. These camps are a great way to improve your all-around game.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CAMP FEATURES

Instruction at the Maverick Basketball Camps will come from former and current Omaha players, outstanding high school coaches and the Omaha men's basketball coaching staff. Each camper will benefit from the following features for a safe, fun experience:

WHERE TO GO

This year's camp sessions will be held at the Lee and Helene Sapp Fieldhouse on the University of Nebraska Omaha campus. Sapp Fieldhouse has six air-conditioned basketball courts. Meals will be available on campus, but the cost is not included.

WHAT TO BRING

Bring appropriate basketball gear and shoes, along with lunch money (\$5 - \$7 is suggested) or a sack lunch for each day of camp. Also bring a signed copy of the required Youth Activity Safety Form (available on OMavs.com). Valuables are discouraged.

FEES AND REGISTRATION

All Maverick Basketball Camps require a non-refundable deposit of \$65 per session to guarantee a spot in the session of your choice. After we receive your completed registration form and deposit, you will be sent a confirmation letter. Your registration will not be processed without the deposit. Final payment of your remaining balance for each session is due at your arrival for camp. Walk-ins are always welcome but are subject to space availability.

CAMP STAFF

In addition to the Omaha men's basketball coaching staff, college and high school coaches from around the Midwest will serve as camp counselors. During camp week, members of the Omaha men's basketball team will serve as assistants and leaders in daily camp activities and drills. We offer an outstanding player-to-coach ratio and feature a veteran camp staff with years of experience in developing young athletes.

A member of the Omaha athletic training staff will be on hand for all camp sessions. We recommend each camper be in excellent physical condition. This not only prevents injury, but it also makes the learning process that much easier.
